When you are navigating through the menus, the selected menu is highlighted with a black frame. The special dial tone indicates an active diversion, an active absence information or waiting messages. After a power failure the phone will restart automatically. However, when a password is requested, you must log on before the phone can be used again. This procedure will also clear the Check the display on your phone and read the required sections in this chapter to continue with the start up procedure. After a power failure the Call List is cleared. In this case you must enter a valid user identity and password. The password is obtained from, and can only be changed by the system administrator. If no key is pressed during this time, "no change" is selected automatically. This mode is reserved for your system administrator. This takes about 1 minute. After a self test, the phone is ready for use or ready for log on. To log on, see section "Log on" on page 21 If no key is pressed during this time approximately. 60 seconds, "Yes" is selected automatically. You can speed up the procedure by pressing the Loudspeaker key. If a power failure occurs, the software must be downloaded again. This is the most common option. You cannot log on or off. This option can be used for phones in conference rooms, receptions etc. If the displayed number is your number The number for SOS calls might vary between countries. The request to enter a password can be changed, contact your system administrator.

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You can log on with your own extension number and get your personal categories. To get the letter A press key 2 once, for B press key 2 twice, to get C press key 2 three times, and so on. Every new word starts with an upper case character that is after a space has been entered. However, you can force the phone to enter all characters as upper case only, or lower case only, see below. This is only valid for the characters AZ. If you for example press 9, the following character options are shown on the display The text Log off is displayed. Stored numbers can consist of a maximum of 32 digits. This can also be used if no external line is free You have to answer within eight seconds, otherwise the

Callback service is cancelled. When the called extension replaces the Frequently used external numbers are stored as Common Abbreviated Numbers in the exchange. Common Abbreviated Numbers can be dialled from every extension that has the authority to do so. Stored numbers can consist of a maximum of 24 digits. You can switch between handset and monitoring, mute the microphone, make an inquiry, transfer the call, establish a conference or put the call on hold to perform other tasks.

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
