When you push the red button on the front, the beads in the canister used to spin but now it does nothing. Any ideas how I can fix it My Hoover wind tunnel Answer questions, earn points and help others. I will stand the vacuum up facing me. Then I put both of my feet mostly my toes lightly on top of the beater bar. I then grab the the body of the vacuum, where the dirt goes, and gently pull and twist it up. It will separate from the head of the vacuum fairly smooth and BAM hand vac! I had a lot of trouble getting the base off, and was worried about cracking it. Was able to get it off by lying it flat on the counter and using a screw driver to put a little pressure on on each side of the base with wheels where the attachment tube for the base goes up into the unit. I applied pressure on one side and then the other and then it came right off. It will not hurt the vac. May be a little hard at first but the wheel unit will come off. The whole thing comes off. I lay mine on the table hold on to the main body hand vac and pull off the bottom piece. Its easy, even I can do it and I have limited movement. The hole at the bottom is also where the attachment goes. Its a wonderful little thing! Enjoy! My bottom piece simply will not disengage itself! It is in no way obvious that you can pull the bottom off without breaking it and the instructions don't explain it. You can unsubscribe at anytime.
