The damage may have been caused by the poor packing job. The unit did arrive very quickly. Good points Dvr feature lets you just set it up to record on the guide days in advance which means no programming vcrs or dvdrecorders. The clock is already set in the receiver. All you do is press select over the show you want to record in the guide and its all set. You can also do a manuel recording where you extend the times if you want to. Over 100 hours of harddrive space Guide goes out 9 days instead of 2 like the 301 Beautiful Picture Quality Sharp and pristine like all of dishes receivers dvd quality. Auto Record I should mention that when you cut it on it records but when you cut it off its erased. This isnt what goes on the harddrive. Recordings are as great as the original picture both in sound and picture. Info on dvr lets you know how many hours are left on harddrive, edit, name etc. Remote has the interactive button for instant access to channel 100 the interactive channel. Receiver has fan to keep harddrive cool. Has all the bells and whistles of the 301 and lets you pick favorites channels on the guide and themes. Bad Points Receiver gets too hot even when its off its hot to the touch. Manuel states you have to unplug receiver before you move it because it can damage harddrive. With the introduction of new personal video recorder models, also referred to as PVRs or DVRs, Dish Network has established themselves as a formidable competitor in the areas of price, selection, picture quality, and customer service. My gripe is with their lack of Dolby Digital and 5.1 surround sound channels. Its enough to be a dealbreaker for audiophiles. This model was a free replacement for an older model satellite receiver being phased out in 2005. A phone call set up the shipment and the process was

The receiver contains standard cable jacks for input and output as well as two RCA audio and video outputs, an S video output, and a Dolby Digital connector. The Dish Networks customer service staff are some of the finest I have talked to in any company. Not only are they friendly and helpful, but Ive found them to be knowledgeable reducing the need for transfers and hold times are usually under a minute. After installing the receiver, activation took less than five minutes and we were up and running before I hung up the phone. Compared to the older receiver, I find this new receiver delivers a sharper picture with improved contrast and clarity. Until now, I gave the nod to DirecTV, but I believe the two are now equal. Dish also fixed some annovances while channel surfing. In the past, pulling up the Dish guide meant obscuring the entire channel. Now the channel is moved to the right corner of the screen, similar to DirecTV, so you can view the current channel while you scan other channels. Another channel surfing option is to flip through the names only of programs on different channels. Unfortunately, this method obscures the top third of the screen with the title of the current channel and the bottom third of the screen with the title of the channels youre flipping through. The size of this obscured screen space could be drastically reduced and still provide the same information. Another new feature is the ability to display the name and phone number of incoming telephone calls for those subscribing to caller id service through their telephone company. Finally, the old receiver used to suffer severe lag in downloading program descriptions. This problem seems to have disappeared entirely. On to Digital Video Recording. This is my first experience with DVRs and I must say they have made the process very intuitive. I havent had to refer to the user manual yet. The most prominent difference between DVR users and those without is the ability to pause live television.

This is easily done via a big yellow pause button on the remote. Once this happens, the DVR kicks in and begins recording from the point you pause. To the end user, it simply looks like you hit the pause on a DVD. As soon as you start up again, the DVR continues to record as you watch so you never miss anything. Because youre now watching recorded television, you now have the advantage of skipping past commercials until you reach the point where youre back to a live broadcast. The only drawback is you will lose what you have recorded if you switch to a different channel. The system does prompt you beforehand so you wont switch back to live mode by mistake. The process may sound complicated but its very painless. If you can operate a VCR, you can operate this DVR. Programming the DVR to record programs is even easier than a VCR in my opinion. Simply scroll through the guide until you find a program you wish to record, then hit the record button. A prompt comes up, select VCR or DVR, and youre ready to go. I did get a tech to admit that it is possible to record one channel while watching another but they are only offering this service to new subscribers. Apparently, replacing the receivers of existing customers to include this feature will tax the current capacity of their system. If your limited to recording the same channel your watching as I am, a timer icon will pop up five minutes prior to warn its about to flip the channel on you. Scroll through the list until you find the program you want, hit the select button, and youre off and running. Thanks to DVR, the remote control is now as intuitive as you can get. This provides the ability to replace your current VCR remote entirely as all the functions are supported. The Dish remote acts as a universal remote for three devices in addition to the satellite. I just wish there were four devices we could add instead of three.

If I didnt have to choose between controlling the home theater system and the DVD player, I could have eliminated all of the remotes in the house. Perhaps its better marketing but DirecTV seems to be the provider of choice for sports fans thanks to their allinclusive sports package. Dish is the winner for music fans thanks to their partnership with Sirius. I counted 140 music channels although Im tempted to exclude the 20 or so channels that are broadcast in mono. This brings me to my only

major gripe with Dish Network the sound quality. Dish Network broadcasts only HBO, Showtime, and a few PayperView networks in 5.1 or 6.1 surround sound. Thats it. All other stations are simply 2channel stereo, including premium channels. I find myself frequently fiddling with the virtual fake surround effects to find a setting I like. Anyone used to the immersive effects of true five or six channel digital audio will find the Dish Network sorely lacking. Since most cable companies do not have this limitation, I have a hard time recommending the Dish as an alternative to anyone owning a home theater system. I betatested a similar service through a cable company years ago and this isnt any better. The service attempts to provide information such as news, weather, sports scores through your television yet the process is so slow and cumbersome youll never use it. The games on cellular phones are higher quality and at least a game on a phone is a onetime fee vs. Hope the review helped. Or just poorly made Each time we have called Dish Network and they have exchanged it, then it takes some time to set up the new DVR and get it synced with your satellite feed etc. Then months later same thing. I should mention that there was one exception one DVR that was sent to us for exchange was faulty right out of the box. The rest took at least 6 months to go on the fritz. Talk to your installer to communicate your installation concerns, and Line of Site issues Most of the time satellite dishes are allowed so long as they are not attached to there building property, and is installed on the ground with a pole or NonPen Mount. Some landlords may require an additional security deposit before allowing installation of satellite dishes. You can reduce your Dish Network monthly bill by simply signing up for Club Dish No charge to sign up and refer your friends and family to Dish Network. Yes, our promotions require a credit card for contractual purposes, as we supply the equipment at little or no cost. We do require that the name on the credit card and the name on the DISH Network account match to prevent fraud. If you do not have a credit card or debit card with a credit card logo on it, than you can also purchase a PrePaid credit card available at retail

merchants. When the account is set up, the credit card number is linked to the account in a secure location that cannot be read by our Customer Service Representatives. We do not recommend painting your dish as it may cause signal loss. If you do decide to paint your dish, do not get paint on the front cover of the LNBF the white plastic cap that faces the dish, and avoid latex and metallic paints. We also recommend that you use as few coats as possible as more paint will increase signal loss. I have trees in front of my dish. What can I do If your system has been installed for a while and you lose signal during clear weather, you may have obstructions trees, buildings, mountains, power lines, etc. causing interference with the satellite signal. If you cannot find a different location that provides a clear line of sight to the satellite, you may have to trim your trees. What can I do about snow and ice on my dish.

If you experience signal loss due to the accumulation of snow and ice on your dish, if safe to do so, gently by hand or with a small broom, brush as much of the snow and ice off as possible. Your signal should return shortly. Spray it with Pam snow and ice wont stick to it. Why do I need a phone line connected to my receiver. A phone line or internet connection is required in order to provide noninterrupted programming. The phone line will not interfere with your telephone use. If the receiver is using the telephone line and someone picks up the telephone, the receiver will immediately stop and try again later. The same will be done if a call is received. The receiver will only use a toll free 800 number. This provides continuous access to DISH Network PayPerView movies and events and allows use of the Customer Support Application and other Interactive TV applications on channel 100. DISH Network PayPerView purchases are stored within your receiver and limited to a specific purchase amount. The phone line connection allows your DISH Network PayPerView purchases to download automatically and be processed by our computers. These purchases are then applied to your regular bill. From time to time, we update the software in our receivers to improve the performance or add new features. There is no charge for these enhancements. Please note that the receiver must be in standby mode plugged in but turned off to receive software downloads successfully. The download process takes between 5 and 15 minutes. It's best to leave the receiver off overnight, or when you are not watching TV for an extended period of time. In our dualtuner receivers, like the DISH 322, DISH PLAYERDVR 522, DISH PLAYERDVR 625, and DISH PLAYERDVR 942, both TV1 and TV2 power indicators on receivers need to be off in order to receive a software download. The time in my Electronic Program Guide EPG is incorrect.

What can I do During an initial activation, the time will be set normally 1015 minutes after the programming is authorized. The time is set according to the ZIP code listed for the physical address, which is federally assigned. If it has been more than 15 minutes since activation, you can perform a Smart Card reset. Caution The Smart Card could be damaged by a Static Electricity discharge. To prevent this, you should touch the outside of the receiver prior to removing the Smart Card. If receiver has not been used in a while this is an issue, and it will NOT be free unless it is new with a warranty which some sellers imply. When Contacting Dish Network to have this Receiver activated, they told me they can no longer add this to a Dish Account.

They are Obsolete, too old, and are no longer supported by Dish Network. The 510 is simple, easy to setup and use. Although it isnt an HD receiver, it does an excellent job of producing near HD playback and is equal to any standard dvd disk. The 510 also has a UHF over the air remote for operation for multiple tvs. The svideo output connects to the main television, while the rf output

connects to the cable running to other rooms. You can also use a simple fix from dish network for extending UHF range for those far away rooms. 100 hours of recorded television is plenty of room. You can also piggy back a dvd recorder and burn a disk off the recorded show. We decided to buy it because to buy a DVR box thru dish net can be costly. Also make sure that the box comes with the card, if the card is outdated, that is ok because dish net will send you a replacement card to update the software in the box. If you have the warranty attached to your dishnet account and the box you recieve will not activate properly, dish net will replace the box. All in all, it is a good deal. Definitely make sure that the box comes with the card and I would also recommend getting a new reconditioned box verses a used one. However it is a matter of choice and what you are comfortable with. Dish net also refunded the cost of the card. The new reconditioned box came with the yellow card, dish net updated the software and sent an updated card. The price between the two were basically the same. It does require access to the dish if you are going to add this as a second receiver. There was a second unused cable connector on the dish that I hooked this receiver to. Access to the connector requires removing three small screws. One has a nut on top that I immediately lost so be more careful that I was. To get it running you will need a new smart card. I called Dish and they send a new smart card by UPS. Once that was installed it was up and running in about a half an hour.

As usual with Dish it took a couple restarts but that was expected also. I choose this receiver because it matched the one I already had. It is no longer available from Dish. I recommend if you are going to add a receiver as I did you match yo ur existing receiver and verify the dish accepts a second receiver. Some of the very oldest ones only have one access connection.
