It appears to be in somewhat good condition. It is just a used camera in a padded box.I like to shoot both film and digital, and these two cameras use the same lenses, which is a plus. I do a lot of photo documentation, and with a negative in hand, there is less chance to claim that something has been photoshopped. This is important in my line of research. The camera itself is a delight to use, and is light weight. The AF is flawless and very fast. The viewfinder is bright, and

the mirror and shutter are relatively quiet, another important quality in my line of work. The grip provides a secure feel, again, which is important in the field. I would recommend the camera body without hesitation. The lens on the other hand is OK, but not great. I do not like lenses without a metal mounting bayonet, so I ditched the kit lens, and replaced it with the better lenses made by Canon. I want a tight, vibration free mount, and I do not trust plastic lens mounts. In all, this was a great bargain, and have already shot several rolls of film with it. It's a plastic camera with a plastic lens mount and a mirror prism, so it weighs nothing! Its frame counter always shows you the frames remaining as it counts backwards. Its advantage is that it weighs nothing and works great. It shoots in all exposure modes and has a modern evaluative metering system. It's an easy camera to knock around all day, and brings back great results, even on Fuji Velvia 50 slide film. If I shot this camera all day, every day I'd want a better finder for my convenience, but as a knock around camera, it's great. The 1993 EOS Rebel XS should not be confused with the Digital Rebel XS that was introduced in August 2008. EOS Rebel G, 1635mm II at 16mm, Tiffen 812 filter, Fuji Velvia 50. I had no manual and had no problems. Personally, I prefer to use my thumb anyway. Even with shots deliberately designed to confuse the meter, it gave OK results, although maybe a half to a full stop different from what I'd get from the infallible Color Matrix meter of the Nikon F6. The Rebel G works perfectly for shots with direct sunlight or blinding reflections shining into the camera. EOS Rebel G, 28135mm IS, Tiffen 81C filter, Fuji Velvia 50, and a reflection off the glass that's blinded many people. The Rebel G ignored the reflection and gave a perfect slide. I recall no warnings from the camera that the flash exposure may have been low; my Nikons tell me when I've made a shot that might turn out too dark with a rapidly blinking flash bolt. It's much better than the puny finders of Canon's 1.6x digital cameras, but not as sharp as the

fullframe digital and better film SLRs. I find the display of the 1Ds Mk III too dim, while the more primitive display in the Rebel G is fat enough and bright enough to be legible in any light. There are three indicators in the bottom digital display that tell you which are active. I prefer this to my Nikon F6, which shows more in the finder than I get on my slides. Advantage Rebel G!

You can set Red Eye mode, the beeper, multiple exposures and bracketing. Its so easy and well thought out it was obvious even without the Users Manual. I had no problems reading it, but bring a small flashlight or pop open your cell phone if you want to read it for night shots outdoors. OFF is the red L position of the big top dial. ON is any other position. I only use the L position when putting it away in a case where the shutter might get pressed accidentally. The counter starts at about 37, and counts down the number of shots remaining. The top LCD blinks the film icon to let you know its time to pull out the film. You can unshift the program by shifting it back to normal, or letting the meter timeout or change the exposure mode dial. You can check this by pointing the Rebel G either at a very bright white in direct sunlight or at a solitary light at night. When you tap the exposure lock button youll see the exposure settings change a lot. The Rebel G selects these for us based on the exposure mode. For instance, sports id AI SERVO tracking and portrait is ONE SHOT focus and lock, etc. If your subject is moving and the Rebel G cant lock in a second or so, it keeps hunting and tracking with the dot off. THis is what my Rebel G does, which disagrees with the Owners Manual. Unlike Nikons, you cant change the sync by itself. It works great for night shots. There is no bargraph indication of by how much youll be underexposed as you have with most Nikons. It beats me why Canon is giving these fullframe lenses away with their 1.6x cameras, and personally I bought a 28135 IS from a friend who got his 40D as a kit with it and didnt want it. The Canon Rebel G uses rolls of 35mm film. Rolls of film are sold in light-tight metal cassettes, which allows the film to be loaded in daylight. You might be able to find rolls for sale at Walgreens, CVS, Walmart, and other stores. Those same stores will also be able to develop the film for you. However, almost all stores no longer do the development in store. They mail the film off to a lab to be developed and you will not get your developed negatives back. You don't need to use a store to develop your 35mm film. Instead, you can just mail the film off yourself to a photo lab, such as The Darkroom. What film to use 400 ISO film is a great choice to use with the Canon Rebel G. It is fast enough to use indoor and shade, but not too fast that direct sunlight makes getting a proper exposure impossible. A film with a lower ISO, like 100, requires more light to expose properly. This means using a larger aperture or longer shutter speed if you're not in sunlight.
