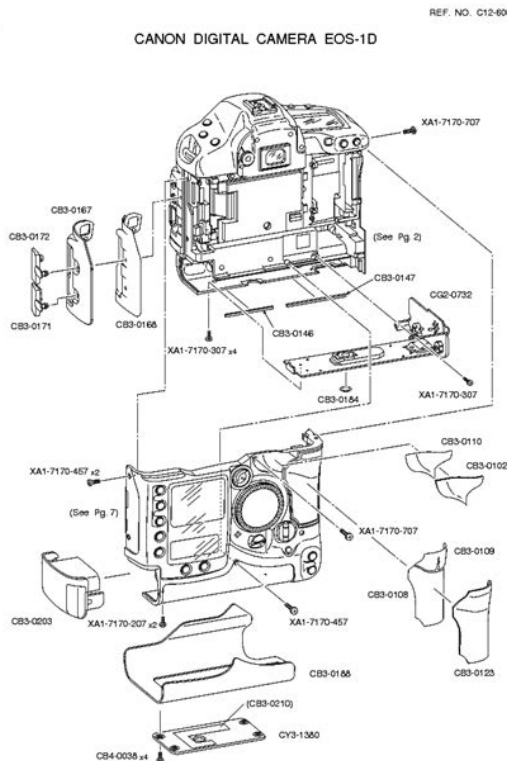

DIAGRAM 1 High Level Connections

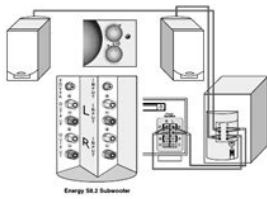


DIAGRAM 2 Using the Subwoofer Output of an A/V Receiver or Processor

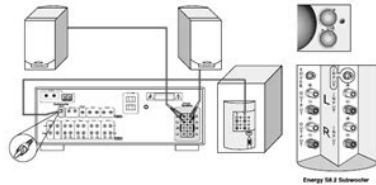
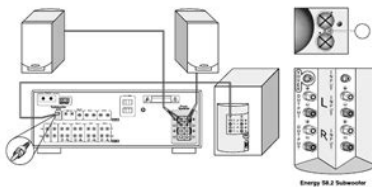


DIAGRAM 3 Using an External Crossover
