# comcast digital cable remote manual

Dont worry, this sounds complicated but its just a simple browser setting. You can usually find JavaScript options in your browsers Settings, Preferences or Internet Options menu. Here are the instructions how to enable JavaScript in your web browser. Press the XFINITY button Enter the 3 digit code shown on your screen Program your remote using a code Turn on the TV you are programming. Type in the 4digit or 5digit code listed below using the number buttons. Additional codes may be found in the remote manual. Most likely code LG 10178, 11265 Panasonic 10051, 10250 Samsung 10812, 10060 Sanyo 10154, 10159 Sony 10000, 11100 Sharp 10093, 10165 Toshiba 10156, 11156 Vizio 11758, 11756 If the code is entered correctly, the status LED will flash green twice. If the status LED blinks red, then green the code was not entered correctly. Check that you are entering the correct code and try again. Use the remote to operate your TV use Power, VOL, etc. If these steps don't work, try another 4digit or 5digit code and repeat the above. Find the 5 digit codes that correspond with the brand of your TV, DVD, or other device in the list below. You may want to write them on a scrap of paper. Read the following steps before performing them. 2. Press the cable button at the top of the remote. This will clear any button pushes from memory. If you mess up on any of the following steps, press the exit button followed by the cable button and start back at step 3. Press either the TV or AUX button whichever one you are planning to program once. If you completed this correctly, the TV or AUX key will blink twice. Be sure to press the cable button to clear the remote. Then press either 0 for another cable box, 1 for a TV, 2 for a DVD, VCR, or PVR, or 3 for any audio device. 5. Press the power button and then aim the remote at your device. 6. Press the channel up button until the device turns off. Stop pressing immediately when the device turns off. 7. Press the setup button to lock in the IR code. The TV or AUX button will blink twice. 8. Check that you did this correctly by turning your device on and off with the remote. If it works, continue. You have successfully programmed your Comcast remote to control your devices. Here are a few reminders that may be helpful. Pressing one of the mode buttons on the top of the remote will set the remote to control that device Pressing the all on button will turn on the cable box, followed by the TV, followed by the AUX device When in cable mode, the volume buttons will control the TV volume Thank you. I know that it is not for computers, but it is the most recent question I have been asked and the most popular. Now, be aware that these instructions are not for the standard silver remote that comes with your cable box. They are for black remote that comes with the DTA box. Instead, you have to use a little black box that is provided by Comcast. Did this help you Please feel free to provide any comments. If that is the case, please leave a comment or use the contact page to send a message and I will help you track down a code that will work! This can take a while and little patience. Then you will need to program it manually using a code. But the channels have stopped working. I'm not sure why this happens, but if this is the case, try the following Please help! I put new ones in and programmed the remote. I unplugged the box for 10minutes and reset it, but still no channel changing. Any suggestions Any suggestions My daughter is blind Can you help me Unfortunately I have never heard of that happening and not sure of a fix for it. Didn't work. Very frustrating. Plead help. It a Samsung series 5000 LED. Thanks. Extremely helpful. The volume and on and off does not function. Cait, who replied above, said it took a few tries as well. Let me know how it turns out for you. If you still have trouble, leave another reply and I'll try to help you. The instructions didn't worked for me. My TV is Sony. Now the only thing that works is the channels. Do you think there is a way to reset the control so it can go back to normal. I just want my controller to work. I would really appreciate an answer back.

I know that this tutorial is a little old but I need help. Thanks. Have you tried manually entering Sony Codes.When you first get a DTA remote, the channels are all you can control. So, if you're able to change channels then that is what I would consider "normal". Was your remote behaving a different way previously I'll be glad to help with that as well. It depends on what kind of TV you have. Some models are weird. I have seen the exact same thing you are experiencing on a friends TV. The best option would be to use a specific code for your TV. You can use programmable codes as well. I'm actually about to append the article to include those instructions as well. I have an article that lists remote codes for TVs. Start with that and if you don't have any luck, send me the make and model of your TV and I'll try to help you track one down. If so, and it didn't work, send me the model number of your TV and I'll see if I can find a code for you. Have you already tried codes for Emerson TV's If you want you can email me through the "Contact Us" page. What do you mean you can't turn your TV on no matter what you do. Do you mean just by the remote or it won't turn on at all You can try resetting your DTA, which is the little box that your cable wire an TV connect to. Simply turn it off for about five minutes and then plug it back in. I've seen it work immediately and I've seen it take a while before it finds a code. Simply press the "Set" button until it blinks twice and then enter the TV code and press "Set" again. If it doesn't work, try the next code. I have a list of TV codes here on the website. It no longer changes the volume, all it will do is change the channel.Let me know if it works or not. If it doesn't, I'll try to track another one down for you. To so that makes it X10 worse. Lol I have channel control, but no volume or no power. I have a list of 10 codes for the Sansui. I've tried all of them with no avail.

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We've had this tv for over 10 years and when we set it up on cablecomcast came out and programmed it and we've never had a problem since. They said they won't come out to reprogram without a charge. So I guess I'm out of luck. It's such an old TV I don't want to spend money on it! Thanks They have been partners with Sansui for while.Please help me, it's very frustrating. If so, try

programming it manually by following the manual method found here. Is your TV an older model. Sometimes this can pose a problem. If you still can't get it to work, send me the make and model of your TV and I'll help you track down the right code. If not, let me know and I'll see if I can find another one. Also, it looks like the company Funai makes Durabrand TVs, so you might try codes for Funai as well. I've found that this works in some cases. Thank You! Maybe I have other problems It sounds like it is getting reset somehow. I will look into for you, but in the meantime I would suggest taking it back to Comcast and trade it in for a new one. I'm sure that is guickly becoming annoying Simply unplug the power adapter from the DTA box, wait a few seconds and then plug it back in. That may help. The boxes themselves can get out of whack sometimes. Keep me posted. I have a Sony KDL32LL150. Any help would be much appreciated. I've getting frustrated. It can be frustrating at times. Sony seems to have a reputation of being problematic as well. Keep trying and I will see if I can track down a code for your model. I press the set button till it blinks twice. I plugged it in and it said it was loading the channels and it loaded to 100 percent. I have a mafnavox tv. I'd like to mention that the code is 991, instead of 911. I don't know if that was a typo or not. Also, if you are not getting a picture it sounds like you may need to call the 800 number and activate your DTA box. It's pretty quick and Comcast has an automated system that sends an activation ping to the DTA.

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Try it again using 991 and if you are still having trouble, reply back and I'll see if I can help you troubleshoot it. You shouldn't have lost your ability to change channels. Try doing a reset on the remote and try again. If you are still having trouble, send me the make and model of your TV and I'll help you track down the proper code. If you need help resetting the remote, I listed the procedure in the comments section here. You shouldn't be losing your ability to change channels. Follow the same steps as I described to her. If not, send me the model number of your TV and I'll help you find a code as well. I hit set and the remote blinked twice. Now the tv won't turn back on. This happened to two tv's. They are both dead. They don't turn on manually or with the old remote. Comcast doesn't know what to do. Do you Has this ever happened to anyone else I have never heard of that happening before. I am completely baffled that you can't even turn your TV on with the old remote or by pressing the power button on the TV. The programming happens to the remote, not the TV so there should be no way you could "unprogram" the TV itself. I have no clue, but I will look into it for you. In the meantime, you might try resetting the remote and see if that helps. You can do this by following the same programming procedure except enter the code 980. You should see the remote light blink four times. This is called an OPS reset and should restore the remote back to its "out of box" state. There are other resets, but I would NOT recommend them as they will completely disassociate the remote from the cable box. Give the OPS reset a try and I will do a little research and see if I can find anything that might help you. No one at Comcast knew what to do and every single one of them claimed they never heard of this before. I knew I was not the only person this happened to, and I'm sure there are other cases. Did you ever get it resolved.

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I have a SHARP LCDtv so I tried code 10093 and the 991 code. I cannot get my remote to change the channels; it will only control volume and power. Thank you! This "soft reset" may help. If not, contact me with another comment or through the contact page and I'll see what else I can do to help. Channels and volume So, here we go. Programming the remote allows you to control your TVs volume and power, but changing channels happens through the DTA box, not your TV. Your TV should remain on channel 3 or 4 whichever you set it to. Your remote should have been preprogrammed to the box it came with. Were you able to change channels before you used the 991 method. If so, then somehow it has become "unprogrammed". If not, then it was never associated with your DTA box to begin with. Please let me know the answer to the above and I will continue to help you troubleshoot that's why I created this website. Don't give up I did this from my EVO btw If

you'll send me the model number of your TV I'll help you find a code that will work. I lost the remote for it but have the small Comcast remote. I've tried every code on comcasts site and your standard 991 nothing works. I don't know the model number. Can't find it anywhere on the tv It will most likely be on the back and you'll probably have to search for it. If that doesn't work, let me know and I'll try to find another code. I can change channels with Comcast DTA remote, but cannot turn on or off or adjust volume. Thanks! Have you tried the 991 method Just for yours or anyone else's knowledge. I have a sharp and the 991 code didn't work but the 10093 code did. With mine it was programmed at the 2nd step. What I mean is when I went to change the channel it didn't turn the tv off, but it did program it. My Xfinity remote, and a RCA universal remote. Nothing will program to my Memorex tv. It's making me want to pull my hair out! It sounds like it's a different one than the DTA remote.

The silver Comcast remote perhaps I flipped through all my channels and I can get like a unclear picture and sound on like 34. I tried to program my little Comcast remote to my Memorex tv to change the channel to 4, but it hasnt been working. I've also tried a RCA universal remote. When you program the little black remote, it will only control the basic functions, such as volume and power. The channels are still changed through the DTA box. Your TV may have been autoprogrammed a long time upon initial setup and skipped channels that it did not find a signal on. You will either need to turn those channels on or conduct another autosearch on your TV. You should have a menu button on your TV that will allow you to do this, and you can navigate using the volume and channel buttons on the TV. If you do not have a menu button, try the following If you need help, you can always comment here! Not sure why it wouldn't have retained the programming, but I would try it again. How do I access the menu I've switched back and forth myself between languages, so I'm not sure why you're Language button isn't working. It's quite possible you have a defective unit. You may have to contact Comcast for this one. Any ideas Are you saving you can't change channels at all I have also tried the 11758, 11756, 10864, and 10885 codes for Vizio and they don't work either; I tried them all twice. Do you have any other suggestions One thing I noticed you said, if the TV is turning off then it has found the proper code for your TV. Double check to make sure you press the "Set" button immediately afterwards and that the red light flashes twice. This confirms that the code has been set. Hope this helps. If not, hit me up and I'll help you troubleshoot it some more. It gets to the point that it should and it goes through channels forever. Also, try programming it using remote codes from LG as well. Keep me updated.

I thought my remote had been programmed, but then tried to change the volume and turn the TV off and it didn't work. On a hunch, I decided to change to new AA batteries and then tried to auto program it again, and it worked! I programed the tv but now I cannot turn the cable box off. I can change channels, volume and the tv on and off. The cable box remains on all the time. Tried reseting the box by unplugging for about five minutes with no luck. Thanks in advance. Rick It's actually designed to stay on. In fact, it's better if you do leave it on. Periodically Comcast sends signals to the box. A friend of mine unplugged his for a while and had problems with it later. According to Comcast support, if the box does not receive a "keep alive" signal periodically, it deactivates after 30 days. Before the only things that weren't working were the power button and the volume. So now after pressingthe set key and 991 it only turns the channel up and never off I have a LG tv Are you trying to program the FAV button to do a custom macro or function, or are you just trying to use it as intended I must not have followed the properly the first time. Thank you I also tried the 911 library look up but stopped after aobut 100 inputs. Do you have a secret code or should I keep going on the library look up. Thanks much!! Wish all things good be this easy, lmao I can see if I can help you track down a code that will work. Let me know how it goes and keep me updated! They instructed me to go out and buy a universal remote because it was not possible to use just one remote any other way. There are some other people who have this problem. Try searching the comments section. Is your TV a newer or older model Any thing els I could try. This signifies that the remote is in

autoprogram mode. Sometimes it can take a while for the remote to find a code as well. I tired the 911 thing and my tv never turned off after. Can u please help me. That one may be difficult to find.

I'll search around and see if I can help you find a code. If you end up finding one, please post it for other readers! I have a Sanyo Patience is definitely required. We just got a new Vizio M370SL and would like to be able to just use the remote that came with the tv, not the Comcast black remote which is only used to change channels. I've googled all over and not found anything. Any help would be greatly appreciated. But that's an interesting thought, I'll look into it and see if it can be done. It should do it when you hold the Set button and then again when you press 991. Then, once your TV has turned off, you press Set one more time and it will blink twice then as well. I can only get the channel buttons to work. The volume and power buttons will not work. I've tried everything, entering the codes, 991, and nothing works. Please help. I tried 10093 but when I pressed channel up it simply just changed the channel via cable. In the meantime, try code 11407. Keep me updated. Its a Memorex MLT1532. Is there a way to program a DTA remote to this TV. Thanks in advance! If that doesn't work let me know. When I turn it back on the volume works but not the channels. I can't get any of the codes to work for more than 1 channel change then it stops. Can you help You can also try changing the default channel on the DTA box from CH3 to CH4. Then change your TV to that channel as well. Let me know how it goes. I seem to remember being able to change the channels when the comcast guy was still at my house. It appeared to work only that day. I watched the same one channel for days and decided to look in my book to program it and did this last night and now can do the above as mentioned but still cannot change the channel. I do not know how to program my TV and I do not know the code. I see there are several codes for a Magnavox. If I need to program to a specific TV type, I need to know the appropriate code and how to do it. Can you help me Thank you so much!!

The other is a Sylvania model 6719DC. Can you help me find the correct codes. Thank you! Andy I'll see if I can find a code for you. If this is the case, then the programming did not take. Try the 991 method again or can try programming it using a code. If you are still having problems, send me the make and model of your TV. I'll see if I can track down a code for you. If you still can't get it to work, send me the make and model of your TV and I'll see if I can find a code for you. It can require some serious patience. If you send me the make and model of your TV I'll see if I can find a code for you. We have a TCL flat screen purchased within the past 2 years. I cannot read the model number as its hanging and the bracket covers up the model number. Any ideas Do you have a TV code for an old Sony Trinitron that will work with the Comcast DTA I went through all 12 of the ones listed in the remote manual, as well as a couple more given to me by Comcast. Two of the codes turn the TV off but unfortunately do not turn it back on. Enter 1 0 0 0 0 Press Pwr. Off went the TV and back on again. I exposed the sensor, as that was my problem!!! Couldnt believe how easy it was. That was it, the sensor wasnt seeing the remote, now I have it to where I can see it and it works fine. There should be an IR remote extender in the box that your DTA came in. It plugs into the back and has a remote sensor attached to it. I think it even comes with some double sided tape. Glad you were able to get everything working!!! I have tried the 991 code multiple times with no luck. I have a LG model 37LG30. Any help would be greatly appreciated! Is your TV an older or newer model I purchased the TV new around 2008 if that helps at all. Appreciate the help. Where's the "vote up" button Haha Thanks! Couldn't have done it with out your help! During my time we had to get up off the couch and turn on the tv, change the channel, adjust the antenna and lower the volume.

Then the remote with the long cord came along that attached to the tv. Your directions were very helpful. Thanks for your time.0 I have tried all of the codes listed at the Comcast site, and also the 991 method. None of these worked, though the 991 method turned the tv off and on but no volume control. Help! Press 993 the red light will blink twice. Press 1 and the light will blink 4 times. This should fix it. It just worked on mine. Hope this helps others also. If you're still having trouble, send

me the make and model of your TV and I'll see if I can track down a code for you. Found this article, ty was programmed in less than 5 minutes!! Thanks again!! That happens sometimes. It looks like you're going to have to manually input the code. Try all the codes listed for Curtis TVs. Try this one as well 11326 I have tried every code and even used the 9 9 0 method to look up the code. Any suggestions This was a solution found by one of our readers!! Have you tried the 991 autoprogram method. My problem is that everything works except the tv will not turn back on once I turn it off. It is a Element ELDFT406. Thanks so much for your website. This is what sets the code and should allow you to use the remote normally. I'm not sure about the Element brand, but I'll see if I can track a code down for you. Keep me updated. I can channel up and down and page up and down and las channel. Please help Have you tried the autoprogram method The remote seemed to have broke and can't seem to link up the Comcast remote. To make matters worse the tv needs to be on channel 3 to get the cable and it is stuck on 4 and we can't get back to 3 manually for some odd reason. HELP!!!!! But now have a bigger problem, the buttons on the actual tv are not responding!! Any help please I've changed boxes twice, Comcast sent out a tech and he claimed he's never heard of this happening. They don't know what to do and my tv will sometimes shut off 4 ot 5 times in several hours.

On top of that, they charge me for this piece of junk. Any ideas I'm not sure what to tell you. I have not heard of that happening either. I have tried all the codes and did the 991 thing to no avail. I get the power to work and the volume, but not the channels. We need help, please. She has a older 36" Sony tv with the big box on the back if that helps. Her fingers are very arthritic to use the old remote. It may need to be programmed manually. Any ideas, suggestions, fixesPS I already reset the box by cutting the power for a little bit. Thanks in advance! Do you have a code for Polaroid My model is TLA04011C I've tried the "best code for tv" and scanning and it won't change the channels its so frustrating. Actually what fixed my TV and remote problem was done by REMOVING the "IR" sp cable that connects to the small black cable box. The Tech people who came to my house told me that it sometimes disrupts the connection to the remote and tv. Now my tv works fine. Removing this wire is usually a solution and is sometimes not needed unless the box is being stored in a secluded place such as behind the tv, a home theater system etc. Hope that helps any other users! Won't blink 2x after 991. Stuck on Channel 8, Ugh boring! Help What is the exact make and model. I'll see if I can find a code for you. Any ideas Make sure you have an unobstructed line to the box. If you want to tuck it away, there should have been IR extender included in the box. It looks like a little black orb. Should have some double sided tape for mounting. It plugs into the back of the black box. I have tried the following codes that were posted in the remote papers 11758, 11756, 10864, and 10885 all to no avail. I have tried the 991 option. Sometimes it can take a while and all that is needed is some patience. However, 11758 should have worked. That code pretty much works with just about every Vizio TV I have come across. Keep me updated. Nothing works!

I can only change the channel not the volume or turn it on or off. Help! They can be finicky when it comes to finding the right code. I have seen in some instances where a code could not be found. Let me know if that one works!! I hope the info button is the guide button. PLEASE HELP!!!! Thank you sooo much It has the codes for various TV's. here's what I did. I held the set button until it blinked twice, entered the code and then pushed the power button and it shut my TV off and then I pushed the power button and my TV came on and works fine now with the remote. I since have received a new remote the smaller black one and digital adapter. Once again, tried reprogramming, but didn't work. Let me know if that works for you. I have a MAGNAVOX TV and the 991 code doesn't seem to work. Do you have a code that will work for my TV possibly I have tried your method multiple times and nothing. This is getting frustrating. I have a Samsung tv and the model code is TXS2782HXIXAA Please help! The remote should always control the channels via the DTA box straight out of the box. I'll see if what I can find out. To work with a Comcast digital adapter remote. None of the listed codes worked. Tried. 991 no luck. Any ideas Thanks. I tried the 991 code but it didn't work. I have a

panasonic tv. Please let me know what else I can do. But I've never heard of that happening. Have you tried reprogramming it I'll be sure to do this when I go to hotels too for when the volume button doesn't work! Hope that helps. Let me know if it doesn't work. I'll try to find another one for you. I have a Sylvania LC320SLX TV. I also tried 10054 and 11864 codes but nothing happened. Please, help me. Thank you, PeteD Since my first post, I tried the following codes, but none of them worked 10171, 11314, 10030, 10020, 10028, 10065, 10096, 11665, 11963, 991, 10054, 11864. Please, if you have any new ideas or codes please help me. Thank you PeteD I don't have any more codes for you.

The only suggestion I have, may be to try the codes again, maybe you skipped one. Or maybe you entered one wrong. I don't know. I'm sorry man. The 991 code seems to work, but we are pushing the plus button for 3 minutes and it doesn't turn off. We went to the website with the long codes, but when I input them it would just change the channel, not just flash. Please help a confused couple I've seen it take up to 1015 minutes for the remote to find a code. In the meantime, can you send the model number of your TV. I'll see if I can help track down a code for you. Although it did not fix why my channels stopped going up and down, but a reboot on that basic adapter that hooks up to the tv did the trick. Now with this remote hooked up to the tv we can eliminate a remote. Always good to have one less remote. It works all the way up to the pressing channel up button, it doesn't turn off. I've tried pressing it at all different speeds. The remote has worked to change the channel since I got it but it won't turn it off or adjust the volume. Unfortunately the person who sold me the tv lost the tv remote so I'm stuck getting out of bed to turn it off every night, waaahh! Try this code 11864 It describes how to fix this issue. The code 10230 worked for me, but unfortunately, I can't turn the tv on without having to press the set button first, then pressing the power button 3 times. Any ideas on how to fix this. I've tried everything that's been posted, but the problem hasn't gone away. I don't know if this is related, but when I turn on the TV "X3" appears in the upper left hand corner of the screen. Would that have something to do with me having to press the power button 3 times. Although, that "X3" would appear on the screen before I programmed the remote, so I don't know. Any help would be greatly appreciated. Same thing to turn the TV off. It's a bit annoying, but better than pressing the power button 3 times like I was doing before.

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
