Its light weight even when filled with water and the vibration is very relaxing. My favorite part is the splash guard because I can paint her nails with ease when her feet are placed on top. I wouldve loved to have given it 5 starts but the water was definitely not heated, even in slightest amount. I poured in very warm water and it was not able to retain the temperature so theres not even the slightest chance that it could heat cooler water. But, for the price, its perfect. Im fairly picky when it comes to products and I really like this product. There are many reviews that mention how loud the foot spa is. I disagree. There is a small fan at the base of the foot spa, but that is for the bubble ambiance. There was one review that mentioned you couldnt even watch TV while using the spa. That review is really exaggerated. I gave my husband a pedicure today and we both watched TV and talked without any issue. If you choose not to buy this product because you are somehow convinced that it is loud, I think you are making a mistake. There are many reviews that mention the heat setting, or lack thereof. No, this foot spa does not heat water. We added warm water equivalent to a bath temperature and 30 minutes later the water was still warm. My husband says that if the water cooled, he couldn't tell. It is interesting to me that there are no reviews with actual temperature measurements. I plan on coming back to update this review next time we use the foot spa. Im going to actually put a thermometer in the water and take measurements. It will be fun to sort the accurate reviews versus those that are exaggerated. If you choose not to buy this product because you are convinced somehow that the water wont stay warm, I think you are making a mistake. This foot spa was comfortable for my husband to put his feet in it and then lean back. I think its important that you take that into consideration when choosing a foot spa.

If the backside wall is too high, you will have to sit at a 90 degree angle as the backside wall will press into the back of your ankles. This foot spa has the perfect backside height so you can lean back in a recliner. The foot spa has a foot in each corner. This prevents it from tipping and worked great. My husband would take his foot out and rest his heel on the blue lid and there was no wavering. I took a few photographs with measurements. A mans size 12 foot will fit in this spa just fine ladies, you know then that all of our feet will fit. My 12inch ruler fit into the bottom, with about an inch more to spare. A mans size 13 would fit, but anything bigger would not be comfortable. The width of the foot spa is about 12 inches. Im really happy with this product. For the price, I think it is a great product. To size it out, Im a mens 13 shoe size, and I have a little room left over, so youll probably start having issues if you wear a mens 14 and up. It can be a bit awkward to carry when full of water. They dont cover it on the webpage, but in the instructions its pretty clear that this needs to be placed on a flat surface so that the air flow to the heating coils doesnt get disrupted, so its probably not ideal to place on thick carpet. To me the vibration was soso. Theres been some debate about the heating capabilities with it. In my experience, it will delay the water getting cooler, but its not able to maintain the initial water temperature for very long. If all you need is something to soak your feet in, a dish tub would make an acceptable alternative. This left my foot semi swollen and in definite need a pedicure. I wasnt allowed to get one for a few months, however, so I purchased the Conair Foot Spa. I did my research, checked costumer reviews and found that this one was the best product within the price range and it did not disappoint.

Aside from finding a level, splashfriendly space to position it, all you have to do is snap the lavender splash guard onto the basin, plug it in, and fill it up with water make sure you don't surpass the MAX level indicator. If you're like us, the last thing you want to do when you're tired is fuss with your foot spa.

The Conair requires little effort—just pull it out, fill it up, grab a towel, and sit back and soak. Once you're finished, emptying the water is a seamless process as the streamlined foot spa weighs just 4.7 pounds. The brand's vibrating foot spa is made of durable plastic and complete with a pearly white basin, lavender base, and splash guard. The splash guard effectively prevents water spillage, while the reservoir comfortably coddles your feet. The same button also allows you to activate vibrations. As previously mentioned, the foot spa is lightweight and easy to carry from room to room, but its 7.5 x 16.6 x 14.6 inch design does take up more space than expected. On a positive note, the device's large footprint means it can accommodate shoe sizes up to a men's 13. There are three different types of nodes, so you can customize your massage by placing your feet in various areas. Soft, vibrating nodes grace the bottom of the foot spa; a pinpoint attachment for extradeep massage rests in the middle of the purple plate above; and the splash guard features additional nodes so you can target your toes or heels. The scorching water we'd poured in was lukewarm before we got through one episode of The Good Place, which left our feet feeling like they were in a bad place. While this was annoying, the product listing does state that the foot spa is only intended to keep your water at its original temperature—so whether you put in cold, tepid, or hot water, the Conair won't heat it. Rather, it's supposed to just maintain your water temperature. We were looking forward to a soothing massage, but we found the Conair unable to effectively massage the pads of our feet. We felt the overall basin pressure was weak, while the pinpoint massage attachment was too spiky and rough. We weren't able to find much of a happy medium. If that's your main ask, though, you might not mind—especially if you add bath salts to make the experience a little more soothing.

Wipe it dry with a towel or let it air dry, and be sure to stay away from harsh soaps and detergents. If you plan to use essential oils or fragrant salts while you soak, just keep in mind it'll require a more thorough wipedown.
